Englishman's search for pleroo in the writings of John and Paul

Look for (1) the **meaning**; (2) the **agent**; (3) the **object** of the verb pleroo (who or what is being filled or completed); and (4) **the content** with which the agent pleroos the object (where applicable).

John 13:18

8 " I do not speak of all of you. I know the ones I have chosen; but it is that the Scripture **may be fulfilled,** 'HE WHO EATS MY BREAD HAS LIFTED UP HIS HEEL AGAINST ME.
