1. One of the ways that grace super-abounds in our lives is with our **spiritual gifts** (**1Co 14:12**). Let's go through the spiritual gifts and describe how they <u>counteract the effects of the reign of sin</u> in people's lives. For reference, here are the permanent spiritual gifts mentioned in the New Testament:

Permanent

Permanent spiritual gifts function <u>throughout the Church Age</u>, until the Rapture of the Church, whenever that occurs.

Speaking:

- Pastor-teacher
- Evangelist
- Teaching
- Exhortation

Serving:

- Helps
- Service
- Administration
- Mercy
- Giving
