CROWNS OF GOLD

Exodus 39:27-31

²⁷ ^aThey made the tunics of finely woven linen for Aaron and his sons, ²⁸ and the turban of fine linen, and the decorated ¹caps of fine linen, and the linen breeches of fine twisted linen, ²⁹ and the sash of fine twisted linen, and ¹blue and purple and scarlet *material*, the work of the ²weaver, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.

³⁰ ^aThey made the plate of the holy crown of pure gold, and ¹inscribed it like the engravings of a signet, "Holy to the LORD ." ³¹ They ¹fastened a ²blue cord to it, to ¹fasten it on the turban above, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Leviticus 8:9

⁶ Then ^aMoses had Aaron and his sons come near and ^bwashed them with water. ⁷ He ^aput the tunic on him and girded him with the sash, and clothed him with the robe and put the ephod on him; and he girded him with the artistic band of the ephod, ¹with which he tied *it* to him. ⁸ He then placed the ¹breastpiece on him, and in the ¹breastpiece he put ^{2a}the Urim and the Thummim. ⁹ He also placed the turban on his head, and on the turban, at its front, he placed ^athe golden plate, the holy crown, just as the Lord had commanded Moses.

2 Samuel 12:30

²⁶ aNow Joab fought against ^bRabbah of the sons of Ammon and captured the royal city. ²⁷ Joab sent messengers to David and said, "I have fought against Rabbah, I have even captured the city of waters. ²⁸ "Now therefore, gather the rest of the people together and camp against the city and capture it, or I will capture the city myself and it will be named after me." ²⁹ So David gathered all the people and went to Rabbah, fought against it and captured it. ³⁰ Then ^ahe took the crown of ¹their king from his head; and its weight *was* a talent of gold, and *in it ²was* a precious stone; and it was *placed* on David's head. And he brought out the spoil of the city in great amounts. ³¹ He also brought out the people who were in it, and ^aset *them* under saws, sharp iron instruments, and iron axes, and made them pass through the brickkiln. And thus he did to all the cities of the sons of Ammon. Then David and all the people returned *to* Jerusalem.

1 Chronicles 20:2

20 ^aThen it happened ¹in the spring, at the time when kings go out *to battle*, that Joab led out the army and ravaged the land of the sons of Ammon, and came and besieged Rabbah. But David stayed at Jerusalem. And ^bJoab struck Rabbah and overthrew it. ² ^aDavid took the crown of ¹their king from his head, and he found it to weigh a talent of gold, and there was a precious stone in it; and it was placed on David's head. And he brought out the spoil of the city, a very great amount.

Esther 8:15

¹⁵ Then Mordecai went out from the presence of the king ain royal robes of ¹blue and white, with a large crown of gold and ^ba garment of fine linen and purple; and ^cthe city of Susa shouted and rejoiced. ¹⁶ For the Jews there was alight and gladness and joy and honor. ¹⁷ In each and every province and in each and every city, wherever the king's commandment and his decree arrived, there was gladness and joy for the Jews, a feast and a ^{1a}holiday. And ^bmany among the peoples of the land became Jews, for the dread of the Jews had fallen on them.

¹¹ "Take silver and gold, make an *ornate* ^acrown and set *it* on the head of ^bJoshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest. ¹² "Then say to him, 'Thus says the Lord of hosts, "Behold, a man whose name is ^{1a}Branch, for He will ^{2b}branch out from where He is; and He will ^cbuild the temple of the Lord. ¹³ "Yes, it is He who will build the temple of the Lord, and He who will ^abear the honor and sit and ^brule on His throne. Thus, He will be a ^cpriest on His throne, and the counsel of peace will be between the two ¹offices." ¹⁴ "Now the ^acrown will become a reminder in the temple of the Lord to Helem, Tobijah, Jedaiah and ¹Hen the son of Zephaniah. ¹⁵ "^aThose who are far off will come and ¹build the temple of the Lord." Then you will ^bknow that the Lord of hosts has sent me to you. And it will take place if you completely ^cobey the Lord your God.
