Mt 3:6 - and they were being baptized by him in the Jordan River, as they confessed their sins.

Mt 3:7 - But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Mt 3:11 -

"As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Mt 3:13 - Then Jesus arrived from Galilee at the Jordan coming to John, to be baptized by him.

Mt 3:14 - But John tried to prevent Him, saying, "I have need to be baptized by You, and do You come to me?"

Mt 3:16 - After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove and lighting on Him,

Mt 21:25 - "The baptism of John was from what source, from heaven or from men?" And they began reasoning among themselves, saying, "If we say, 'From heaven,' He will say to us, 'Then why did you not believe him?'

Matthew 28:19

19 " Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, NASU

Mr 1:4 - John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

Mr 1:5 - And all the country of Judea was going out to him, and all the people of Jerusalem; and they were being baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins.

Mr 1:8 - "I baptized you with water; but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

Mr 1:9 - In those days Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan.

Mr 10:38 - But Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or to be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?"

Mr 10:39 - They said to Him, "We are able." And Jesus said to them, "The cup that I drink you shall drink; and you shall be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized.

Mr 11:30 - "Was the baptism of John from heaven, or from men? Answer Me."

Mr 16:16 - "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned.

Lu 3:3 - And he came into all the district around the Jordan, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins;

Lu 3:7 - So he began saying to the crowds who were going out to be baptized by him, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

Lu 3:21 - Now when all the people were baptized, Jesus was also baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened,

Lu 7:29 - When all the people and the tax collectors heard this, they acknowledged God's justice, having been baptized with the baptism of John.

Lu 7:30 - But the Pharisees and the lawyers rejected God's purpose for themselves, not having been baptized by John.

Lu 12:50 - "But I have a baptism to undergo, and how distressed I am until it is accomplished!

Lu 20:4 - "Was the baptism of John from heaven or from men?"

John 1:25

25 They asked him, and said to him, "Why then are you baptizing, if you are not the Christ, nor Elijah, nor the Prophet?" NASU

Joh 1:26 -

John answered them saying, "I baptize in water, but among you stands One whom you do not know.

John 1:28

28 These things took place in Bethany beyond the Jordan, where John was baptizing. NASU

John 1:31

31 "I did not recognize Him, but so that He might be manifested to Israel, I came baptizing in water." NASU

Joh 1:33 -

"I did not recognize Him, but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, `He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.'

John 3:22

John's Last Testimony

22 After these things Jesus and His disciples came into the land of Judea, and there He was spending time with them and baptizing. NASU

John 3:23

23 John also was baptizing in Aenon near Salim, because there was much water there; and people were coming and were being baptized — NASU

John 3:26

26 And they came to John and said to him, "Rabbi, He who was with you beyond the Jordan, to whom you have testified, behold, He is baptizing and all are coming to Him." NASU

Jesus Goes to Galilee

4 Therefore when the Lord knew that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John NASU

John 4:2

2 (although Jesus Himself was not baptizing, but His disciples were), NASU

John 10:40

40 And He went away again beyond the Jordan to the place where John was first baptizing, and He was staying there. NASU

Ac 1:5 - for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

Ac 1:22 - beginning with the baptism of John until the day that He was taken up from usone of these must become a witness with us of His resurrection."

Ac 2:38 - Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Ac 2:41 - So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

Ac 8:12 - But when they believed Philip preaching the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, men and women alike.

Ac 8:13 - Even Simon himself believed; and after being baptized, he continued on with Philip, and as he observed signs and great miracles taking place, he was constantly amazed.

Ac 8:16 - For He had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Ac 8:36 - As they went along the road they came to some water; and the eunuch said, "Look! Water! What prevents me from being baptized?"

Ac 8:38 - And he ordered the chariot to stop; and they both went down into the water, Philip as well as the eunuch, and he baptized him.

Ac 9:18 - And immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he regained his sight, and he got up and was baptized;

Ac 10:37 - you yourselves know the thing which took place throughout all Judea, starting from Galilee, after the baptism which John proclaimed.

Ac 10:47 - "Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we did, can he?"

Ac 10:48 - And he ordered them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to stay on for a few days.

Ac 11:16 - "And I remembered the word of the Lord, how He used to say, `John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'

Ac 13:24 - after John had proclaimed before His coming a baptism of repentance to all the people of Israel.

Ac 16:15 - And when she and her household had been baptized, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.

Ac 16:33 - And he took them that very hour of the night and washed their wounds, and immediately he was baptized, he and all his household.

Ac 18:8 - Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, believed in the Lord with all his household, and many of the Corinthians when they heard were believing and being baptized.

Ac 18:25 - This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in spirit, he was speaking and teaching accurately the things concerning Jesus, being acquainted only with the baptism of John;

Ac 19:3 - And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" And they said, "Into John's baptism."

Ac 19:4 - Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in Him who was coming after him, that is, in Jesus."

Ac 19:5 - When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Ac 22:16 - `Now why do you delay? Get up and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on His name.'

Ro 6:3 - Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?

Ro 6:4 - Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

1Co 1:13 - Has Christ been divided? Paul was not crucified for you, was he? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?

1Co 1:14 - I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius,

1Co 1:15 - so that no one would say you were baptized in my name.

1Co 1:16 - Now I did baptize also the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I do not know whether I baptized any other.

1Co 1:17 -

For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, not in cleverness of speech, so that the cross of Christ would not be made void.

1Co 10:2 - and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea;

1Co 12:13 - For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

1Co 15:29 - Otherwise, what will those do who are baptized for the dead? If the dead are not raised at all, why then are they baptized for them?

Ga 3:27 - For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

Eph 4:5 - one Lord, one faith, one baptism,

Col 2:12 - having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

1Pe 3:21 - Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you--not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience--through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,
