Evangelism Orientation

- 1. **WHY?** Why do you want to evangelize on the beach today?
- 2. **WHO?** Who are the people you are likely to meet?
- 3. **WHERE?** Where will this activity occur?
- 4. WHEN? At what time, what day, when do you expect to be with these people.
- 5. WHAT? What do you want to tell them? What do you want to happen?
- 6. **HOW?** How are you going to go about getting a hearing for the gospel with people on the beach? If you were these people, how would you like to be treated by a stranger who comes up to you and wants to tell you something important?
- 7. WHAT NEXT? What can this person do to learn more about Christ or about us?

1. WHY? Why do you want to evangelize on the beach today?

I want people to believe in Jesus Christ so they will receive eternal life and not go to the Lake of Fire. Christ died for these people and God loves them, so I want to have and show that same love for them.

2. WHO? Who are the people you are likely to meet?

Retired people. Young people on vacation – partying. People from foreign countries. Down and out people. PEOPLE!! Real people with their own life stories, desires, thirsts, disappointments, hurts, angers...

3. WHERE?

Deerfield Beach near the pier.

4. WHEN?

Sunday July 13, 2014 from 1 PM to 3 PM

5. WHAT? What do you want to tell them? What do you want to happen?

I want to tell them that God loves them.

I want to tell them about Jesus Christ, God's Son, their Savior.

I want to tell them that Christ died for sinners, and since they are a sinner, He died for them.

I want to them that Christ really rose from the dead on the third day.

I want them to know that I am a witness to the power of the cross and resurrection of Jesus Christ: that's who I am now.

Whoever believes in Christ will not perish but will receive eternal life.

I want this person to believe in Christ and be reconciled to God.
