## **#1: WHEN:** Our salvation has been secured across all time.

Bottom line: our salvation has been secure from all eternity past and is secure for all of eternity future.

# #2: HOW: The way that we have been saved makes us secure. It cannot be reversed.

We have been saved by **the death and resurrection of Christ**.

We have been saved by God's grace Eph 2:8-9

We have been saved by **hearing the gospel (good news)** preached....*Eph 1:13-14 Rom 10:14-17* 

.....through faith – by believing the good news about Christ.

We have been saved **by God foreknowing us**, **predestining us**, **calling us**, **justifying us**, **and glorifying us**.

Our salvation is **God's work** from start to finish. God's work is perfect. (see #3). We contribute nothing. No man shall boast. No created being had a hand in providing it to us. Our salvation therefore rests solely on the character of God.

### #3: The perfection of the death of Christ (complete, allsufficient)

Christ's death on the cross is the **one perfect sacrifice** for <u>all time</u> and for <u>all of the sins of mankind</u>.

Christ's death **completely satisfied the claims of God's righteousness against the sinful human race**.

Christ **defeated the enemies of God** at the cross.

Christ **reconciled the world to God** at the cross.

All sins were forgiven by the blood of Christ

He accomplished **eternal redemption** 

He made us complete

### **#4: Where – the security of our position**

**At the cross**: we have been placed into His death. We were crucified with Christ. We were buried with Him and raised with Him.

**In Christ** : Our position now and forever is in Christ because of our baptism (meaning we were placed into Christ permanently when we believed)

#### In the hands of the Father forever.
