

## The Two Kinds of Patience in the New Testament

	<i><b>Makrothumia</b></i>	<i><b>Hupomone</b></i>
<b>Directed towards</b>	People	Circumstances, particularly adverse and difficult ones
<b>Opposite is</b>	Anger and revenge	Cowardice & despair
<b>Definition</b>	Forbearance; which creates a gracious lenient attitude toward others. Patience in respect to people.	Courageous endurance; a patient steadfast waiting with hope. Putting up with suffering, affliction and persecution
<b>Literal</b>	“long temper”	“to remain under”
<b>Not...</b>	Not lashing out	Not quitting
<b>Image</b>	Long fuse	Holding on to the bunker (fort) under constant fire
<b>Concerning God</b>	Often used of God	Seldom (if ever) used of God
<b>Connected to</b>	Related to LOVE	Associated with HOPE amidst PERSECUTION
