Teaching Summary for Isaiah 56: part 6

Isaiah Chapter 56

In Isaiah 56., the LORD states the requirements for receiving His blessings. He does this for three groups of people: the people of Israel, the eunuch, and the foreigner.

In each case, one of those requirements is to keep the LORD's sabbaths and not profane the sabbath.

This evening, we will finish our discussion about the Sabbath in the scriptures. We are answering four questions.
