Definitions

Eternal Security: the fact that once a person believes in Christ as their savior, they are saved forever and can never lose that salvation. (John 5:24; 20:31) Eternal security is the work of God which guarantees that God's gift of salvation, once given, is possessed forever and can never be lost.

Assurance: the believer knows for certain that he or she is saved forever. (1 John 5:13)
